



# Pilot Kit: Low Country Approach

Short Base leg at KARW



The Beaufort County Airport (KARW) was voted as one of the most difficult fields to spot from the air by AOPA. This is the case today as you've not been able to pick up the runway until now. You're on a short base leg and will need to turn to final soon in order to line up with runway 25. For whatever reason you're not able to get the weather at the airport so you'll have to look at the windsock as you get closer. The pattern at KARW is right traffic for runway 7.

Location: Less than one (1) mile SE of Beaufort County Airport (KARW) at 750' HDG 330°, inbound for landing Rwy 25.

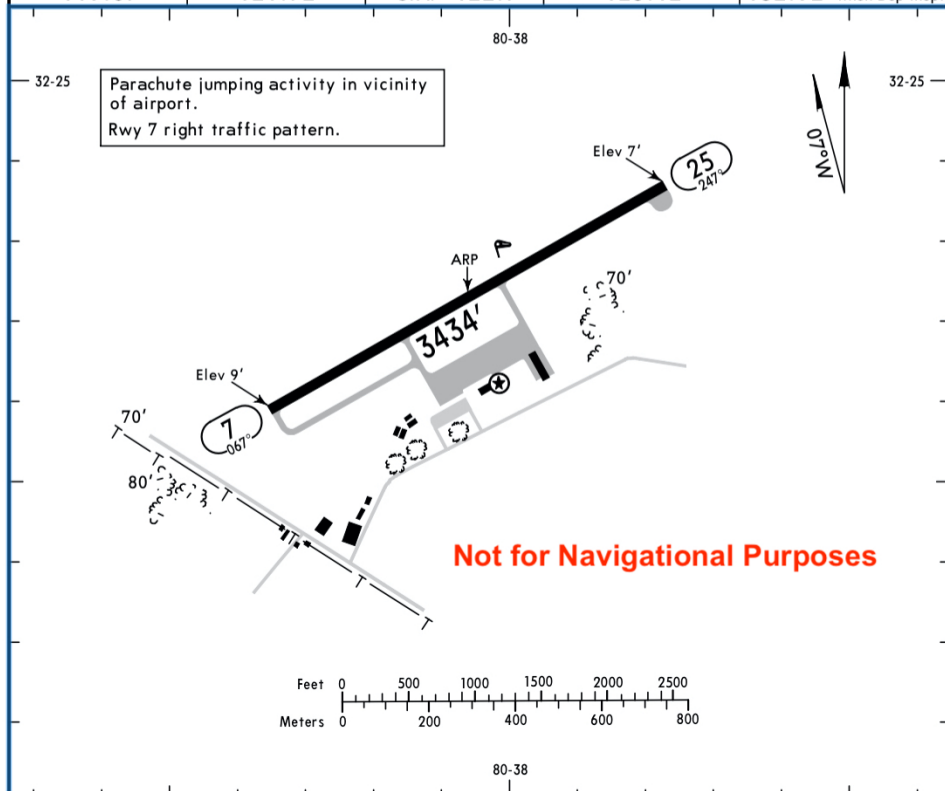
